

AWC Racquetball League Rules:

- A. The “host” for each game is responsible for scheduling the matches.
- B. Scoring:

Points can only be scored by the serving player and points are the result of winning a rally that began with a successful serve.

During play, a player loses the rally if any one of the following occurs:

1. The ball bounces on the floor more than once before being struck.
2. The ball does not reach the front wall on the fly.
3. The ball flies into the spectator's gallery or wall opening or strikes an out-of-bounds surface above the court's normal playing area.
4. A slow ball strikes another player without the estimated speed and/or direction to strike the front wall.
5. A ball struck by a player hits that player.
6. A penalized hindrance.
7. Switching racquet hands during a rally.
8. Touching the ball with either the body or uniform.
9. Carrying or slinging the ball with the racquet.

Under USA Racquetball rules, matches are best of three games with the first two games to 15 points and a third game to 11 points, if necessary. USA Racquetball rules do not require players to win by two, so a match score line could read 15-14, 14-15, 11-10.

- C. In W-L form on the scores chart to the right of your schedule each week.
- D. At the end of the league play period (or during the season), your score sheets will need to be returned to the League Director.
- E. Single Elimination tournament will start December 20th.
